DOT-SIGHTS

Variety of red-dot & reflex sights is available.



FRS: Low profile rear flip-up sight. FFS: Low profile front flip-up sight Can be use as back-up or primary sights

Step 1

Pull the two locking pins (#1 & #2) out by pushing them thru the RONI. The pins have detents to prevent them from being pulled out completly.



Step 2

Pull the butt stock to full extension by pressing the button on the rear side of the stock (#3).




Slim shape & low profile polymer Picatinny light/laser mount.

Diameter: 1" (25.4mm)/0.75" (19mm) **#PLS1/34** - screw tightened. #PLS1Q/34Q- quick-release.










Open forearm-grip to a vertical position by pushing release button (#5) and swinging grip down into vertical position (#4).



Step 4

Lay the RONI down on its side - muzzle points left. Slide parts #6 & #7 to fully extended position.

Some RONI models includes locking screws (A & B). In such case, make sure to unlock them prior to installation. Note: the screws are not mandatory & you can un-screw them all the way out - it will not affect the tightness.



Step 5

Open the body on its bottom hinge (#8).





Step 9

Push part **#7** up against the slide. As pictured above, make sure that the muzzle (#11) covers the pistol's slide & make sure the screw is well tightened (#10).



Step 10


IMPORTANT: If your RONI model includes it, make sure that both safety-catchs (#9) are locked at the same position. Close the body (#8) and push parts #6 & #7 back together into locking position, then completely reinsert the locking pins (#1 & #2).

Step 7

Place pistol into position - make sure it is laying flat & the pistol's trigger guard located well against the RONI frame (#B). If your pistol has an under barrel rail slot, It must be located well against the male rail bar on the RONI (#A). In order for the RONI to close properly, make sure the pistol and slide attachment are locked into position.



Changing between short/long frames (such as Glock 19/17 or Jericho PSL/PL), unscrew #10. Then, adjust #11 to the accurate position, so you can re-screw it securely. To be sure that the fitting is correct, you must insure step 9.
